Directions to Double Tree Hotel- Monroeville

From PA Turnpike I-76: Take Exit 57 towards Monroeville-Business Route 22. Go West on Business Route 22 for two miles. Follow signs for Monroeville Mall Main Entry - bear right (crossing over Route 22). Continue to the stop sign, turn left onto Mall Drive. At 1st light make Left onto Mall Boulevard. Entrance to our hotel near Monroeville, PA is first left on Mall Boulevard.

From Pittsburgh: Follow I-376 East to Exit 80 Business Route 22. Proceed two miles and take the drive on the right which is marked Hotel/Convention Center. Follow to first stop sign, turn left onto Mall Drive. At 1st light make Left onto Mall Boulevard. Hotel Entrance is first left on Mall Boulevard.
